^{*}Quarterly fees include enrollment fee (\$50 USD per quarter), integrated lab fee (\$190 USD per quarter), technology fee (\$75 USD per quarter), and Student Services/Activities fee (\$50 USD per quarter).

^{**}The "Books & Supplies" portion of the budget includes \$1435 USD for Doc Bag in Qtr 2 and equipment fee and \$845 USD in Qtr 1 for purchase of the computer required of all 1st year NMD students.

^{***} Board Exams are included in the budget once the application has been approved by the Registrar's office. Financial Aid can only pay for, and update the COA for required board exams that are paid for during the time the student is enrolled. Generally, students take part 1 during enrollment which has an estimated cost of \$525. Students start taking board exams at the end of Quarter 6.
