



Non-degree seeking students may enroll in certain courses offered through the College of Graduate Studies. Enrollment as a non-degree student does not imply a commitment to grant program admission at a later date. If subsequently admitted to the degree program, up to 15 non-degree credits earned at UWS with a grade of B or higher may be applied toward the degree.

### Admission

Non-degree seeking students must submit application through the university website. A bachelor's degree or a first-professional degree (e.g., DC, ND, MD, etc.) from an accredited institution is required and a student must submit a copy of their official or unofficial transcripts prior to registering for graduate studies courses. Applicants are advised to review program entry requirements, course prerequisites, and course descriptions to consider whether their academic background would support successful completion of graduate level coursework.

### Course Enrollment

Non-degree students may take up to eight credits per term. Non-degree students:

- Receive grades for non-degree coursework that are recorded in the student's academic transcript.
- Are subject to all policies relevant to degree-seeking students. Refer to the university policy portal.

**Note:** Courses that require admission to the program are not available to non-degree students. Courses within in the MS in sports medicine and the MS in diagnostic imaging programs are not available to non-degree students.

### Tuition and Fees

The current non-refundable application fee applies. Tuition for non-degree students is assessed at the same per credit rate as for degree students.

### Financial Aid

Financial aid is not available to non-degree students.
