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DC Graduate Enrollment in Core Curriculum Courses

Individuals holding a doctor of chiropractic degree from an institution accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE) may make application to register to complete core curriculum doctor of chiropractic courses at UWS.

To be admitted as *modified schedule* students under this policy, the doctor must submit a notarized copy of her/his doctor of chiropractic diploma or an official transcript confirming his/her DC degree. S/he must also submit a written request to the registrar explaining the nature of the intended enrollment, which must be accepted by the chief academic officer.

Students enrolled under this policy may not participate in adjustive technique labs or in clinic.

Students enrolled under this policy are able to pay tuition in accordance with Policy 3022 – Modified Schedule Tuition – DC Program.

Audit Option

Enrollment to audit courses may fulfill the doctor's needs. Auditing a course provides access to the information, and may be arranged so that attendance can be confirmed. No individual coursework is required of the student, and there is no evaluation of the student's work. Tuition to audit courses is assessed at one-half the current tuition.

Enrollment according to the terms of this policy is permitted at the sole discretion of the university.
