

University of Western States (UWS) establishes program admission requirements.

UWS considers an applicant's academic background, as well as positive social and humanistic qualities. Motivation, scholastic achievement and an authentic desire to serve are important factors. Applicants may be required to take part in an interview prior to admission.

UWS offers equal educational opportunities to qualified students without regard to race, color, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, national origin, national citizenship, religion, age, disability and veteran status.

Admissions requirements are made available to applicants and to the public in published admission materials, in the UWS catalog and on the university website. Educational and other prerequisites for admission vary by program.

Applicants who have been previously expelled from University of Western States are ineligible for enrollment in UWS academic programs.
