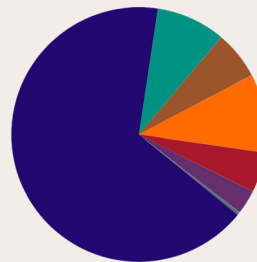

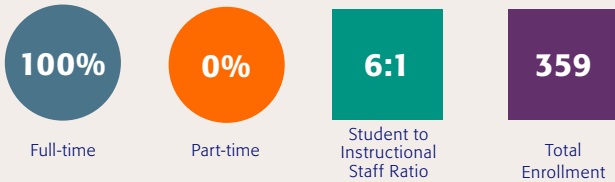

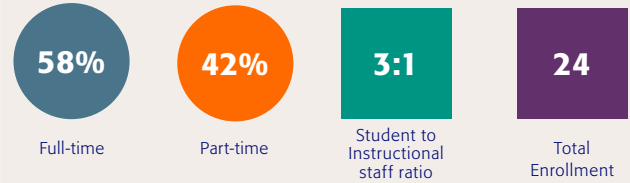

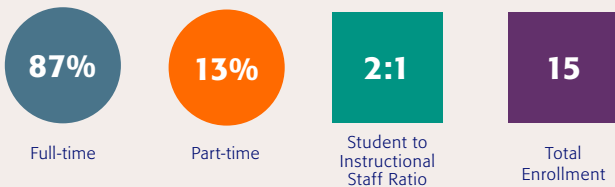
Sports Medicine (Master of Science)

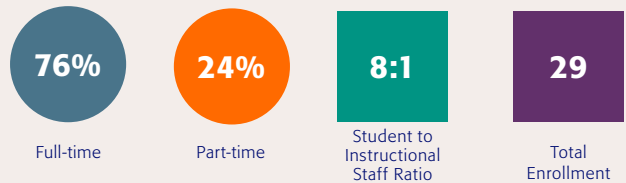
Doctor of Education (EdD) - Clinical Mental Health Counseling Specialization

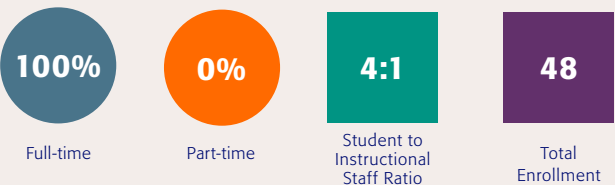

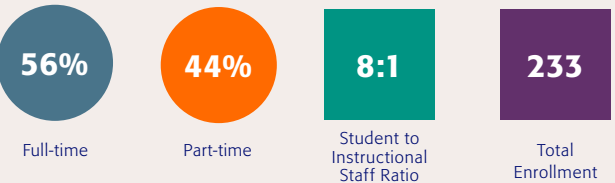

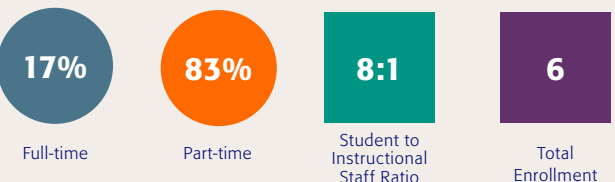
