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Change in Concentration, Degree Level, and/or Program

11/17/2022

UWS students enrolled in applicable programs may request to change their program concentration, degree level, and/or academic program as indicated in this policy.

### **Concentration Changes**

Students intending to remain in the same academic program and credential level may <u>contact their</u> <u>student success advisor</u> to initiate a concentration change.

### Eligible programs with concentrations:

#### **Degree Level Changes**

Students admitted to a degree program (e.g., EdD, MS) may revise down a credential program level (e.g., MS, CERT) within the same field without having to re-apply for the new program, as long as all admission requirements have been met. Students choosing to seek a lesser credential than their original admission may contact their student success advisor to initiate a credential program level change.

A change in credential level may impact financial aid eligibility. Students are responsible for contacting the <u>office of financial aid</u> to determine financial aid eligibility.

# **Academic Program Changes**

UWS students intending to make changes to their academic program that are not listed above must apply for and be accepted into the academic program they now intend to pursue. Students who elect to discontinue the academic program into which they originally matriculated and enroll in a new academic program via the admission process must withdraw from their original academic program.
