



University of Western States uses electronic mail (email) to communicate with students, employees, trustees and others. Email communication constitutes an official form of UWS notification. Email sent by the university to UWS email accounts is presumed to have been received and read.

Scope

The policy applies to all individuals with a UWS-provisioned email account.

Email As Official Means of Communication

The university-assigned email account is an official means of communication. Official notifications from the university, such as academic decisions, conduct decisions, grievances, appeals, etc., are delivered via UWS email. Students and employees are responsible for information delivered from the university via their UWS email account.

Students and employees are required to use their university-assigned email account when engaging in business or academic activities with UWS.

Acceptable Use of Email

Email users are required to comply with university policy on acceptable use of information systems. Violations of university policy may result in disciplinary action appropriate to the user.

Security of Email

University of Western States does not guarantee the confidentiality, security or reliability of email services. Users are responsible for understanding these limitations and using caution when using UWS email to communicate confidential or sensitive information.

Privacy of Email

Use of UWS email should not be considered completely private. For more information, see the "Privacy" section of the university policy on acceptable use of information systems.
