



This document is the process and procedure guide for [Policy 9010 Vaccination Requirements for On-Campus Students](#).

On-Campus Student Requirements

In order to satisfy Oregon state requirements, full-time students who are admitted to an on-campus UWS program are required to:

1. Download and print a copy of the [Certificate of Immunization: Measles](#) form.
2. Demonstrate satisfaction of the measles requirement through ONE of the following methods:
 - a. Provide the dates of your two measles vaccinations, which must be on or after the first birthday and at least 30 days apart.
 - b. Provide documentation showing the date of the second dose of measles vaccination on or after December 1989.
 - c. Provide documentation of a titer blood test demonstrating immunity to measles.
 - d. Provide signed documentation of a medical exception from a qualifying medical practitioner (MD, DO, ND, or NP).
 - e. Qualify for a non-medical exemption by watching the [Oregon Health Authority's informational video](#) and attaching a copy of the video's completion certificate.
 - f. Qualify for a non-medical exemption by providing a copy of the *Oregon Health Authority's Vaccine Education Certificate for College Students* signed by a qualifying medical practitioner (MD, DO, ND, or NP).
3. Return the *Certificate of Immunization: Measles* form and any necessary supplemental documentation (if required) to the office of student services in accordance with the following due dates:
 - a. **Domestic students:** domestic on-campus students are required to submit a completed *Certificate of Immunization: Measles* form by the end of their first term of enrollment.
 - b. **International students:** international on-campus students are required to submit their completed *Certificate of Immunization: Measles* form prior to the first day of classes.
 - c. **Transfer students:** transfer on-campus students are required to submit their completed *Certificate of Immunization: Measles* form prior to the first day of classes

University Procedure

1. The office of student services collects the *Certificate of Immunization: Measles* form and any necessary supplemental documentation (if required) and enters the immunization information into the student record system upon collection.
2. Copies of the physical measles forms are stored in the student's physical record in the office of the registrar.



3. The University of Western States office of institutional effectiveness reports aggregated immunization data to the Oregon Health Authority in accordance with the relevant statutes and regulations.
