VA Puget Sound is proud to introduce Lily Ho, DC, as their 2022-2023 Chiropractic Resident. University of Western States has been affiliated with VA Puget Sound since 2010 and is the primary chiropractic academic affiliate for the VA Puget Sound residency program.

Dr. Ho is a 2021 graduate of Cleveland University-Kansas City and is the 3<sup>rd</sup> resident at VA Puget Sound. During school, Lily was active with SACA, participated in a VA student clerkship at VA Kansas City Health Care, worked in a private hospital setting, and currently serves as a Committee Member for the ACA Commission on Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion. Dr. Ho shared, "My time as a resident has been one of the most challenging and rewarding experiences of my life. Thus far, my rotation with spinal cord injury particularly stands out, and allowed me to practice communicating the role of chiropractic in health care with other medical specialties."

The VA Puget Sound residency program was launched in the summer of 2020 by Program Director Clinton Daniels, DC, MS, and was awarded accreditation by the Council on Chiropractic Education in August 2022. Program alumna Morgan Price, DC ('21) and Kevin Meyer, DC ('22) are now both permanent members of the VA Puget Sound team.

The VA Puget Sound residency program provides supervised chiropractic clinic experience serving veterans and managing complex cases while learning to navigate a hospital-based system. Their residents are afforded the opportunity to rotate through primary care and specialty clinics including, but not limited to rehabilitation care services, spinal cord injury, radiology, neurosurgery, orthopedics, pain clinic, primary care, neurology, emergency medicine, and rheumatology. VA Puget Sound residents are also very involved in scholarly activities and, to date, have presented at ACC-RAC, WFC, and published articles in BMJ Open, Chiropractic and Manual Therapies, Journal of Bodywork and Movement Therapies, and Journal of Chiropractic Education.
