

Lab Cleaning Protocols

GENERAL SAFETY

Instructors and students must always wear a face covering over the mouth and nose.

- Thoroughly wash hands and wrists with soap and water prior to entering any lab session.
 - In the event hand washing is not possible or feasible, sanitize hands upon entering lab.
- Sanitize hands after any touching of the face covering.
- Leave the room to take a drink of water.
- Sanitize hands when leaving at the conclusion of lab.

No sign-in sheets should be passed around class.

Stay 6 ft apart except when practicing in a pair.

Use one table for one partner and a second table for the other.

CLEANING

Product: Re-Juv-Nal safety and use instructions can be found in the classroom.

At the end of each class session, put on cleaning gloves and thoroughly spray down the tables, stools (including underneath), bolsters/wedges/adjusting boards when used.

Gloves are recommended to avoid skin irritation.

- Allow the Re-Juv-Nal to sit on the equipment for 10 minutes wet.
- Instructor or TA wipe off excess Re-Juv-Nal from the equipment after 10 minutes.

Spray disinfectant onto a towel to wipe down the disinfectant spray bottle after use.

Spray outside doorknob before leaving the room.

Spray and wipe the keyboard, mouse, microphone, and AV equipment used.

- Spray disinfectant on microfiber towel and gently wipe down exposed exterior surfaces. To prevent inadvertent damage, do not allow any moisture/liquid into any openings and do not let any moisture/liquid pool on the unit.
- Place used microfiber towel in unlined recycle bin next to podium.

Spray inside doorknob as leaving room.

Sign, date and indicate the time of room exit on the posted tracking sheet (using own pen).

In the case that instructor is leaving the room during the 10-minute disinfection period, post a "cleaning in progress" sign on the door.
